NOTE:

1. Trainees registered for SGY 1020, ORT1080, URO1012, PSG 1013, ENT 1017, NSG 1040 will **ALL** sit for the SGY1020 Principles of Surgery examination.
2. ORT 1080, PSG 1013, URO 1012 and NSGY 1040 Trainees will in addition sit for their programme specific examinations.
3. Trainees registered for MED1030, IDM 1016, ANR 1018, will all sit for the MED1030 Principles of Medicine examination.

4. Trainees registered for PED 1090 and PNR 1019 will all sit for the PED 1090 Principles of Paediatrics and Child Health examination.
5. Only candidates that have successfully registered for the examination and appear on the examination register will be allowed to sit for exams (Period for Exams registration 21st Oct – 10th Nov, 2024).
6. Possession of an official ZACOMS trainee identity card will be required to sit for any of the examinations.
7. Candidates need to pass the theory examinations (those taking more than one theory examination, will need to pass them all) to be invited to take part in the clinical examinations.
8. Results for the theory examinations (for those taking clinical examinations) will be published on Friday 13th December 2024 by 22:00 to notify those invited for the clinical examinations.
9. All theory examinations will be held online using google classroom at designated examination centres.
10. Candidates sitting for examinations out of their stations (provinces in some cases) must make personal arrangements for travel and accommodation.
11. All candidates should present to their respective examination centers on the day of their theory examination with a reliable, fully charged lap top computer, tablet or iPad with a power extension cable and a reliable and fast internet access point/ modem as all theory exams will be conducted online.
12. **NO** Cell Phones will be allowed into the examination hall.
13. All self-sponsored students must ensure that their fees are paid in full and that they have obtained clearance from the Registrar's office to sit for examinations prior to the date of commencement of their examinations.
14. The 2024 ZACOMS Academic year calendar provides for a week's study break (1 – 8th December, 2024) but this should be taken in consultation with the Head of Training at each site so that service delivery is not disrupted.
15. All trainees are expected back at their clinical area and to be on normal duty the day after their last examination.
